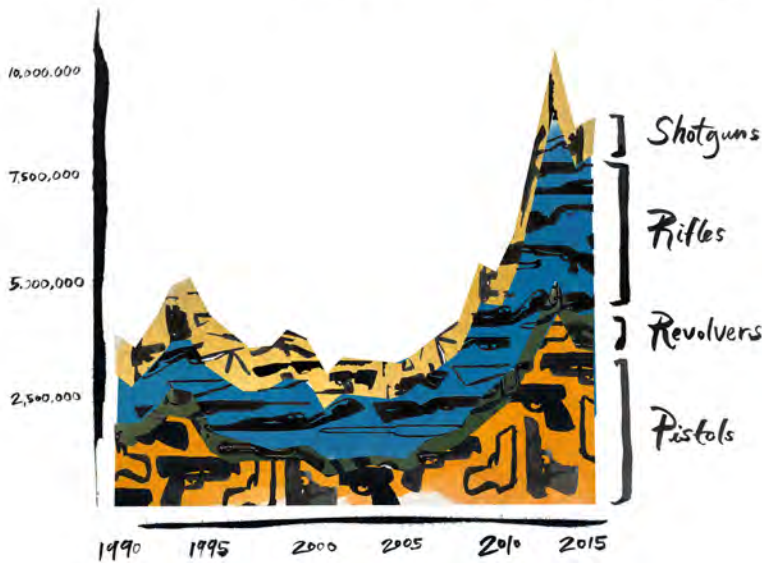


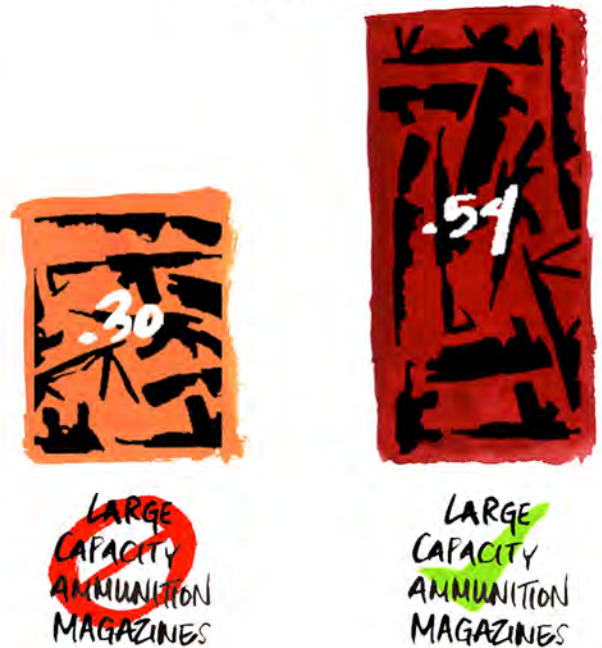
CULTURE + REGULATIONS

Michael Siegel, MD, MPH, of the Boston University School of Public Health has developed the most comprehensive multistate-level database on gun ownership, firearm policy, and firearm mortality in the U.S. The research presented here was produced using the database to examine the inter-relationship among these factors and gun culture. These data provide insight into that kinds of strategies that are most promising for addressing and reducing firearm violence. statefirearmlaws.org

120 lives would be saved every year

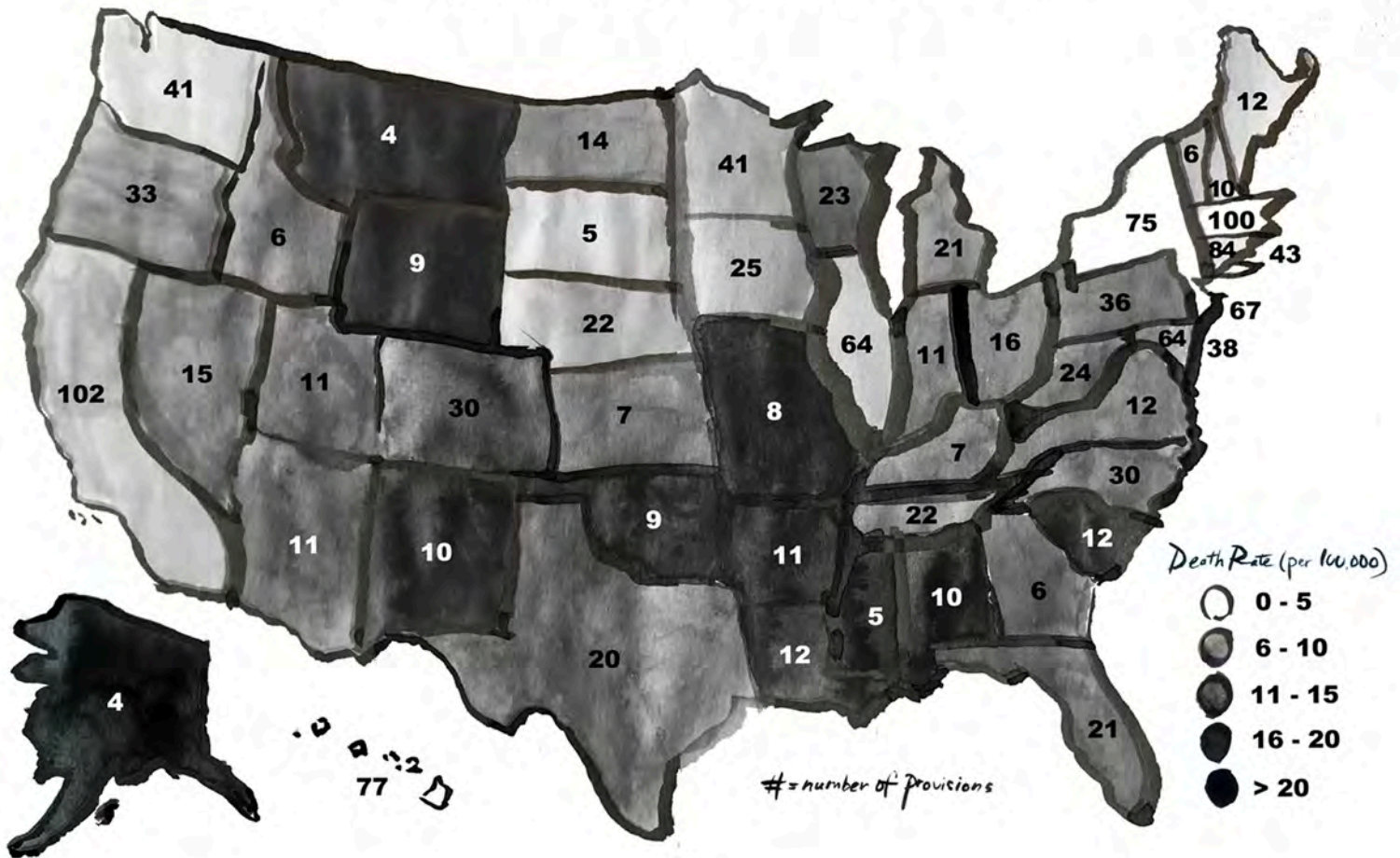
9 states have "may issue" laws that give authorities some (vs none) discretion in issuing concealed carry permits
