Community

who do you identify with? who can you speak on behalf of, knowing you have a representative?

Community looks like love to black feet (kitsikokomiim)

gathering, grouping, commonality

community is a group of people/folks that share a history, or a sense of place, or identity, or social position that come together for a purpose

community is self and collectively defined

community evolves to: include, welcome, engage, change and heal together

individual identity that one share with others with similar identity regardless of their role position in society

a collaborative environment of cultures, beliefs, influences and values melted together that hosts individuals

people with shared experiences, disparities, traditions, cultures

family

a grouping around common characteristics or behaviors, having common histories or ways of operating

self-identified, contested, shared

shared values

a collective group of people who have shared values or concerns

the people that are within a network or classification. Do people have to identify with the "community" in order to belong to it?

people in relation to each other

collective shared identities, space, values, practices & lived experience

a gathering of shared values, culture & mission to create workable & livable spaces

community is a group of people that share culture, power, and resources

general - a group of people who share a similarity in common such as faith, belief, culture, or some other characteristic. ie "The community" - black people

misunderstood as a laboratory

a group of people sharing geographic, cultural, ethnic, generational, gender, or sexual orientation in common

a collection of individuals with a shared why or identity

fellowship and commonality! even in differences being able to find a common ground

where we sleep, work, study, play people who share similar values, culture, etc

self-defined group with values together

groups of individuals with a shared characteristics: space time resources demographics interest

persons who are a part of a shared experience, social status

community

authentic partnership with various sectors (ie CBPR)

the people, their culture, and the environment they live in

group bounded by common/shared experiences that can be immediate or generational

a gathering of shared values, culture & mission to create workable & livable spaces

family, neighbors, churches, schools, villages

common: interests, ideas, place, things

- needs supporting partners
- i might not understand or never use cultural humility agreement.
- need guidance

sense of commonality, shared values and norms and commitment to building on strengths to address identified challenges

can mean many things and should be defined by the people it refers to. For me community reflects groups of people that I am a part of. This is dynamic & often fluid.

a group that shares certain unifying characteristics

family, church, school, places of work, organizations, our higher education institution

misunderstood as a laboratory

- intimate living with those around you
- finding common ground that affects us as using them to come together
- unconditional love with conditional acceptance while being together

grows of multiple people in a surrounding city

people in one location coming together on one accord to create a lasting change

same experiences & values

community works together in function or struggle (interrelated)
