Process to verify the scientific results

value of the work

checking to see how your work went and what is possible through your work

A process of reviewing

examining something or someone to gather information

THE PROCESS OF REVIEWING SOMETHING THAT HAPPENED IN THE PAST

Information

a thorough look and take on anything or anyone

Process to verify the scientific results

method used to analyze data, research, to find if they are effective for solving problems

Misunderstood to be after the fact instead of throughout

exploring the processes and input and outcomes

The act of questioning and placing value

documenting changes resulting from actions in whatever format

Assessment

Determining results of an outcome

To analyze co-late, generate results of an inquiry

the method or tools to find out if a certain activity or research project has made an impact. evaluation should be done in a manner that is relational to the culture who participated in the project

To examine what has happened and describe the outcome

how completely did we answer our question, or solve our problem?

honest assessment

Examining and creating

go beyond project goals to "ripple effects"

To review information through a value-set lense

review of results and their effect or change or solutions
